

## Brucellosis Certification Agreement Farmed Cervidae

### Requirements

Brucellosis certified status is awarded to farmed cervidae herds that have been found negative to two consecutive herd tests for brucellosis at intervals of nine to fifteen months. Herd tests must include all sexually intact farmed cervidae 12 months of age or older.

To maintain brucellosis certified status, herd tests must be conducted within 33-39 months from the anniversary date.

Newly assembled herds may be granted the brucellosis status of the source herd if all animals originate from the same herd. Herd additions must originate from (1) a certified free herd or area or (2) must be tested and found negative to two official brucellosis tests. The first test must be conducted within 30 days prior to movement. The second test must be conducted no less than 60 days following entry into the herd. Herd additions must be kept separate from the accredited herd until the second test is completed.
