

## Tuberculosis Accreditation Agreement Farmed Cervidae

### Requirements

Tuberculosis (TB) accredited status is awarded to farmed cervidae herds that have been found negative to two consecutive whole herd TB tests at intervals of nine to fifteen months. Whole herd tests must include (1) all farmed cervidae 12 months of age or older and (2) all farmed cervidae under 12 months of age that were not born on the premises. To maintain tuberculosis accredited status, whole herd tests must be conducted every 36 months.

Newly assembled herds may be granted the TB status of the source herd if all animals originate from the same herd 33-39 months from the anniversary date.

Herd additions must originate from (1) an accredited free herd or area or (2) must be tested and found negative to three official TB tests conducted no less than 90 days apart. The first test may be waived if herd additions originate from a herd that was negative to a whole herd TB test within the previous 365 days. The second test must be conducted within 90 days prior to movement. The third test must be conducted no less than 90 days following entry into the herd. Herd additions must be kept separate from the accredited herd until the third test is completed.
