

## Exhibition Requirements for Chickens, Turkeys and Game Birds

*Waterfowl and pigeons do not have any exhibition requirements*

### Identification

- All chickens, turkeys, and gamebirds at exhibitions, except baby poultry, must be individually identified with a leg or wing band.
- Young poultry that are too small to band, can be exhibited as a group if the Hatchery Permit number or NPIP number is written on the cage.



### Poultry Testing Requirements

- All chickens, turkeys, and gamebirds, and hatching eggs from these birds must originate from a hatchery or breeding flock that is NPIP Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) Clean or be negative to a pullorum-typhoid test within 90 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition.
- All turkey hatching eggs, poults, and turkeys must also originate from a hatchery or breeding flock that is NPIP Mycoplasma Gallisepticum (MG) Clean and Mycoplasma Synoviae (MS) Clean or be negative to a *Mycoplasma gallisepticum* (MG) test and *Mycoplasma synoviae* (MS) test within 90 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition.
- All poultry must be accompanied by a certificate or test chart that shows compliance with these requirements. Examples include forms listed and those with pictures below\*: NPIP VS FORM 9-2, NPIP VS FORM 9-3, NPIP VS FORM 9-3I

**POULTRY EXHIBITION STATEMENT OF ORIGIN**

In the State of Minnesota, all chickens, turkeys, and game birds at exhibition must meet the following requirements:

- Be individually identified with a leg or wing band;
- Originate directly from a National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) classified Pullorum-Typhoid (PT) clean hatchery or breeding flock; or be negative to a PT test within ninety (90) days prior to exhibition;
  - o Turkeys must also originate from an NPIP Mycoplasma gallisepticum (MG) and Mycoplasma synoviae (MS) clean hatchery or breeding flock; or be negative to an MG and MS test within 90 days prior to exhibition.
- Be accompanied by a certificate or test chart approved by the board to show compliance with these requirements.
- All birds from another state must also meet Minnesota Import Requirements
